AIS Items of Interest

Safety Task Force. Kathy reported that the group is meeting.

Office. Several members shared the results of discussions within their groups on the matter of opening an office. One individual missed being able to stop by the office and browse the literature; another missed the opportunity to socialize; a third valued the experience of serving as a volunteer. There was, however, general agreement among the groups that (1) the current literature distribution system is working well; (2) office costs would not be offset by any substantial benefits; and (3) finding volunteers would likely prove to be a challenge.

Mike M. made a motion for AIS to continue operating without an office and to review this matter in one year. Cheryl seconded the motion. The vote was 18 for the motion, with 1 abstention.

AIS meetings. There was further discussion (from the May AIS meeting) on the format for AIS meetings. All who spoke wished to continue meeting on Zoom except for the "Bring a Friend" meeting. Kathy will investigate holding that meeting in-person during October or November.

On a related topic, several members expressed an interest in having Founder's Day (last week of February) meet in-person if possible.

AA Convention.

Mimi reported that the organizers of the 2022 AA Arizona State Convention (August 26 th-28th at Casino Del Sol in Tucson) have asked if AIS is interested in setting up a literature table at the convention. All sales would go to AIS. Frank said that he would need to purchase additional literature as soon as possible. Sue said that AIS has sufficient funds to make the purchases. Sue made a motion to provide literature for sale at the AA Arizona State Convention. Ricki seconded the motion. The vote was 17 for the motion, 1 against, with 2 abstentions. Sue will try to add Square as a purchase option (in addition to cash or check). Mimi will coordinate with Mike M and Frank in sending out a virtual sign-up sheet for volunteers wishing to help set up the table and work two or three hour shifts at the convention.
